Thinking Strategically

- **Framed Animal Health and Welfare 2020: A strategy for Animal Agriculture in Canada**
- **Canadian Pork Council flags animal health as part of its strategic plan and there is considerable alignment in the outcomes.**
- **CPC includes these outcomes in our input into the new agriculture policy framework and the CFIA-led Animal and Plant Health Strategy**

- ***Code of Practice for the Care and Handling of Pigs***
- 2014
- **ACA, part of the CQA program is being updated to reflect the code requirements.**
- **Animal care will be given greater exposure with the release of PigCare in 2018**
- **Swine Innovation Pork: Swine Cluster 1-2**
 - Groups such as the Prairie Swine Centre play a big role in getting the message out to producers
