**RE: Job posting for Executive Director of the NFAHW Council**

The National Farmed Animal Health and Welfare Council is seeking an Executive Director to provide leadership as the Council continues its development by taking on enhanced responsibilities with respect to national farmed animal health and welfare. The role will be located in a home office and will require some travel. The role will begin as soon as possible for the selected candidate. While the role will start under contract, there is intention to make the position permanent.

The NFAHW Council was formed in 2010 as an advisory council to the FPT Regulatory ADMs and all other stakeholders in animal agriculture. It is a unique organization which considers issues of importance to animal agriculture in a One Health context. Council members include experts in animal health and public health and come from the federal government, provincial/territorial governments and industry/non-government organizations.

The Executive Director will be responsible for all operations and program activities, including planning, budgeting, monitoring and measuring success, networking, stakeholder collaboration and communication and human resources.

The ideal candidate will have strong organizational, communication, networking and leadership skills with previous experience in management roles in an agricultural organization. Demonstrated business operations experience, grant writing experience and the ability to work in both English and French will be assets. The candidate must be a self-starter, able to work from a home office in a virtual team environment, be a skilled communicator, have good project management skills and be able to use common office software.

Education – A professional designation is required.
