## Equipment

Acquisition of two distribution units and 8 manifolds in 2017

- Equipment with Canadian Registration Numbers (CRN)
- Capacity of 2 medium-sized chicken barns at the same time or the largest chicken barn in Quebec



#### **Agreement with Agro Extermination**

- Agro Extermination: pest management company specializing in agriculture with about ten field employees
- Use of equipment from 2018, but first contract signed in 2020 with annual review as needed
- EQCMA responsibilities:
  - Assumes normal equipment maintenance costs
  - Maintains CO<sub>2</sub> gassing protocol up to date (based on CFIA protocol)
  - Maintains insurance on equipment for fire, theft, vandalism



### Agreement with Agro Extermination (cont'd)

- Agro Extermination responsibilities:
  - Stores the EQCMA equipment in its facilities
  - Repairs or replaces equipment if negligence or loss
  - Commits to respect the EQCMA protocol when using the equipment
  - Maintains liability insurance for the use of equipment
  - Informs EQCMA on each use of the equipment and submits a report
  - Maintains 3 people trained in the use of equipment



### **Agreement with Agro Extermination (cont'd)**

- Financial issues:
  - Agro Extermination charges a storage fee to EQCMA
  - Agro Extermination charges personnel, travel, biosecurity and equipment use fees to producers according to the agreed rates
  - EQCMA charges equipment use fees to Agro Extermination

## Challenges

- Loss of interest of some employees
- Fewer planned regular on-farm depopulations in the future (i.e. spent hens)
- Negative impact on day-to-day business operations: more of a disruption than a business opportunity
- Civil liability during interventions
- CO<sub>2</sub> supply and exploration of a mobile container
