

Vision: A sustainable agriculture and agri-food sector strengthened by an inclusive industry-government collaboration protecting the health and wellbeing of farmed animals.

Purpose: Animal Health Canada (AHC) provides a formal structure for the industry-government collaboration required to successfully implement the animal health components of the Plant and Animal Health Strategy for Canada (PAHS).

Structure: AHC encompasses a pan-Canadian, public-private collaboration built on the guiding principles of accountability and decision-making open to the participation of both levels of government and all animal industry sectors.

Mandate: AHC undertakes actions and delivers programs that achieve high standards of animal health protection and economic risk mitigation, consistent with the objectives and guiding principles of the PAHS.

GUIDING PRINCIPLES:

- A governance structure and mandate based on formal commitments between the participants with the flexibility to evolve over time.
- **Pre-determined** accountability.
- Informed decision-making.
